Inland Double/Twin - Inland facing rooms with private bathroom

Seaview Double/Twin* - Sea facing rooms with private bathroom

Premier Cottage Double/Twin* - Spacious sea facing rooms within a converted Fisherman's Cottage adjacent to the hotel, with spa bath and separate shower

Premier Balconette Double/Twin* - Luxurious sea facing rooms with Balconette/French doors, and luxury bathroom.

Dietary Requirements - Please advise, when making your reservation, if you require a vegetarian menu or have any special dietary requests.

Car Parking - The hotel has limited private car parking, charged at £5 per night (please book, when making your reservation); alternatively the village car park is 50 yards from the hotel, and is payable via a meter in the car park.

Dogs are welcome and are charged at £7 per dog, per night (not including food).

Check-in/out - Check-in time is 3pm. Check-out time is 11am. Later check-out is available by arrangement at a charge of £10 per hour (latest check-out 1pm).
